The Cable Station was established in 1902 by the Cable and Wireless Company of London, UK as a trans-Pacific telegraphic cable relay station, until the mid-1950s. It then operated as a scientific field station known as the Pacific Equatorial Research Laboratory (PERL). Now it is operated by the Meleagi Tabwai Secondary School. The Atoll Institute proposes to restore it to the condition as pictured here, circa 1981.
